Extra accreditation for delegation members: 100 Euros for 2 days. Participants accommodated at a non official hotel will have to pay 100 Euros accreditation fee to the organizers.

**Financial conditions**

EURO 330,00 per person which includes accommodation in double rooms at the official Hotels and full board, transfers from Friday, February 23<sup>th</sup> (Dinner) until Monday, February 26<sup>th</sup> 2007 (breakfast). There will be an additional Hotel charge of EURO € 60 per night in case of single room occupancy (if available).

Please make payment via bank transfer before Monday **13<sup>th</sup> of February 2007**. If payment is made after this date a surcharge of 10 % will be levied upon the total payable amount. Possible reservation of extra rooms at the check-in will also be surcharged with 10 %, No exceptions will be made.

All bank fees and bank transfer costs are to be paid by the participating federation.

Cancellation fees: up to 30 days before the arrival, full refund. From 30-15 days before the arrival 50% of the payment. After the **10<sup>th</sup> of February 2007** any cancellations of rooms or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs. Cancellations of rooms **cannot** be made at the check-in. **Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.**

**Entries**

a) First entry

National Federations are requested to inform the German Judo Federation whether they will participate in the tournament or not by prescribed entry form not later than December 5<sup>th</sup> 2006.

b) Final entry

Each federation will have to send to the German Judo Federation the very precise composition of its delegation (enclosed form) by January 30<sup>th</sup> 2007. EJU-Rules: Inscription by IJF-member federations to the EJU until the deadline 12<sup>th</sup> February 2007 to [www.europejudo.com](http://www.europejudo.com) / Electronic System / JUMAS. The European Judo Union has fixed participation fees for super world cups, to be paid on the spot:

from Europe                      € 10,-- per participant\*  
from outside Europe          € 150,-- per participant\*

*\*2006 cost susceptible to be changed for 2007 after the EJU Congress on December 8<sup>th</sup> 2006.*

<b>Remarks</b>	Please make sure that your team arrives <b>prior to 18:00 h</b> , Friday, February 23 <sup>th</sup> 2007 as no additional or any change of entries will be accepted after 18:00 h.
<b>Transfer</b>	Federations which reserve rooms in the official hotels of competition can make use of all transportation. They will be picked up at the airport or train station and after competition transferred back to the airport or train station. Federations not staying in official hotels can't use transportation.
<b>Liability</b>	Neither the organisers of the event, nor the German Judo Federation (nor any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with this tournament. The German Judo Federation declines all responsibility.
<b>Advertisement</b>	Please observe the rules of the EJU as far as advertisement on the Judogi is concerned. Please note that as to the year 2007 all athletes taking part in EJU ECs as well as World-Cups and Super-World-Cups have to carry their surname plus the NOC Code to their federation on the back of their judogi.
<b>Judogis</b>	Please note, that blue and white judogis will be obligatory.
<b>Antidoping control</b>	The anti-doping control will take place after the awarding ceremony.
<b>Special Rules</b>	This tournament is classified as Super-World-Cup on international level; the number of Athletes per nation is the following <b>Europe:</b> 2 competitors maximum per weight category <b>Asia, Africa, Oceania,</b> <b>Pan-American:</b> 1 competitor maximum per weight category <b>Organising nation:</b> 4 competitors maximum per weight category
<b>Visa</b>	For nations, who need VISA to enter Germany, please send us as soon as possible (latest 3 <sup>rd</sup> February 2007) the list of participants with names, passport numbers, birth dates and function. Please be informed that the letter of invitation will be send by regular post. Any other request will be charged to the applying federation (e.g. express mail service).
<b>Attention</b>	For good reasons sake we would like to draw your attention to the fact that the originators will be held liable to make good and repair all damages caused by the athletes or officials during their stay at Hamburg. Please, note that the hotel personel will perform a room examination prior to your checking out.
<b>TRAINING CAMP</b>	<b>The Training Camp following the Super-World-Cup will be organised in Hamburg from 26 February to 2 March 2007.</b>
