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Visa

For nations, who need VISA to enter Russia, please send us as soon as possible (latest 1 April 2007) list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of delivery and expiry of passport, date of birth and function. Please be informed that the letter of invitation will be send by regular post. Any other request will be charged to the application federation (e.g.express mail service).

IMPORTANT: From this year Russian Ministry of Foreign Affaires has changed rules of issuing invitations for foreigners. The procedure has become more complicated and long. **That is why you are strongly recommended to send your visa application forms not later than 1 April 2007.**
