<b>SPECIAL RULES</b>	This tournament is classified as World-Cup on international level; the number of Athletes per nation is the following: <b>Europe:</b> 2 competitors maximum per weight category <b>Asia, Africa, Oceania, Pan-American:</b> 1 competitor maximum per weight category <b>Organising nation:</b> 4 competitors maximum per weight category
<b>VISAS</b>	For nations, who need VISA to enter Portugal, please send us as soon as possible (latest 20 <sup>th</sup> April) the list of participants with names, passport number, date of birth and function.
<b>FLAG&amp;ANTHEM</b>	Each participating country must bring one (1) flag and a cassette tape/compact disk with the national anthem (short version).
<b>REFEREES.</b>	Every Federation should bring an EJU or IJF Referee. Maximum number of referees inscribed per country: Organising Country: <b>8</b> referees Participating Country: <b>2 Male + 1 Female</b> referees Non-Participating Country: <b>1</b> Referee
<b>ANTIDOPING</b>	The anti-doping control will take place after awarding ceremony. The Gold Medal Winner and another Drawn Medallist from the rest (TWO tests PER WEIGHT CATEGORY contested) will be selected for the anti-doping control.
<b>JUDOGI.</b>	<b>White and blue</b> judogi will be required. The size of judogi and publicity placed on the judogi must be in conformity with IJF and EJU rules.
<b>ADVERTISEMENT.</b>	During the tournament no back numbers on the judogis are allowed unless specified by the organizer. Back numbers of previous tournaments must be removed from the judogi.
<b>LIABILITY.</b>	The Portuguese Judo Federation (not any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible neither for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with these championships.
