**TECHNICAL MANUAL
FOR JUDO
(Draft 1 – JULY 2006; Revision February 2007)**

1. INTRODUCTION

The National Olympic Committee of Serbia will host the IX edition of the European Youth Olympic Festival from 21st to 28th of July 2007 in Belgrade.

All sport events on the EYOF programme are held under the authority of the International Federation concerned. The delegate from the European Judo Union for the event will be Mr. Eddy KOAZ (ISR).

The National Olympic Committee of Serbia has entrusted the Judo Federation of Serbia (JFS) with the organization of the Judo matches. JFS will supervise the technical organization of the competitions through its national delegate Mrs. Lidija POPOVIĆ, and the local technical delegate Mr. Milan MIJALKOVIĆ. The Competition director is Mr. Dragan ATANASOV.

The festival will take place from 21st to 28th July 2007:

2. ACCOMODATION & SPORTS FACILITIES

All athletes will be lodged at the OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE, Tošin Bunar 143 - 157.

Competitions

The competitions place for Judo will be the "NEW BELGRADE" SPORTS HALL, Pariske Komune 20.

The place is able to host both competitions and warming up sessions.

Training

A training schedule will be issued according to specific requests and on a first come-first served basis. Training sessions will be possible from Saturday 22nd July.

Training will take place in the "IVAN GUNDULIĆ" School, up to 10 minutes walking distance from the "NEW BELGRADE" SPORTS HALL.

3. PARTICIPANTS AND RULES

Participation

Each delegation may enter up to max 12 judokas in 8 different categories, 2 officials and 1 referee. One referee is compulsory only for delegations entering more than 8 judokas. The referees must be of international category.

Judokas competing in the EYOF must be of the nationality of the country/NOC they represent and must be born in 1991 or 1992.

4. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Rules

The competition will be held in compliance with the latest rules and regulations of I.J.F.

The competition is individual, for both boys and girls and Judokas can compete only in the weight category in which they are enrolled.

The duration of each contest (real contest time) will be four minutes (4') for boys and girls.

The double repackage elimination system will apply.

The draws will take place during the technical meeting through a computerized system according to the rules of the EJU.

The European Champions and Vice Champions in charge will be scheduled before the draw.

Events scheduled:

Participation is reserved to boys and girls with a minimum grade of 3rd Kyu (green belt) in the following weight categories:

GIRLS (7)	BOYS (8)
-44 kg	-50 kg
-48 kg	-55 kg
-52 kg	-60 kg
-57 kg	-66 kg
-63 kg	-73 kg
-70 kg	-81 kg
+70 kg	-90 kg

Each category must have a minimum 8 entries, or the event will not take place.

Official weight-in procedures

The weight-in will take place on the same day as the competition for the category concerned.

The judokas' weight must fall within the category in which they are enrolled.

The fighters are not admitted to the competition without undergoing weigh-in. They must present themselves only once at the official weigh-in and submit their "pass".

The weigh-in is not mixed: the boys cannot assist or participate in the girls weigh-in and vice versa.

Important note

A special referee rule, for this category, will be applied for *shime-* and *kansetsu waza*.

-Arm locks: from the moment that the arm of Uke is in a nearly stretched position or an executed ude *garami*, the referee will announce Ippon (in general, from the moment that the referee thinks that the arm locks will be efficient and before it will injure the fighter).

-An athlete who has lost consciousness by *shime waza* cannot continue the competition.

Uniforms

Judokas must wear white and blue jodogi.

5. JUDO TECHNICAL TEAM LEADER MEETING

The Judo technical Team Leader will take place on Monday 23th of July 2007 at the OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE.

A maximum of two representatives per delegation (officials or technical managers, together with an interpreter if required) may attend the Judo Technical Team Leader meeting.

On their arrival in Belgrade, the delegation leaders will receive 2 access cards each. Without these cards participation at the Judo Technical Team Leader meeting is strictly prohibited.

The agenda for the Judo Technical Team Leader meeting will be as follows:

- Check of entry forms and documents (passports, official identity card) upon accreditation.
- Opening ceremony and welcome by the Judo Competition Director.
- Briefing by the EJU technical delegate.
- Technical managers' roll call.
- Technical information relating to training sessions and competitive events.
- Computerized draw. No changes may be made after the draw has taken place.
- Doping control procedures.
- Medal awarding ceremonies.
- Answers to written questions submitted by the delegations.
- Any other business.
- (Schedule according to opening ceremony.)

At the end, will be held also a meeting for the referees.

6. EYOF INFORMATION CENTRE

The EYOF Information Centre will be located at the OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE. Each delegation will have a pigeonhole assigned where all necessary information will be posted.

Printed information will be distributed daily:

- Starting list (which will be available the previous evening).
- Results of events
- Timetable changes or any other useful information.

The same information will be distributed also at the Office of the OC Secretariat, situated in the Competition Sport Hall.

7. MEDAL AWARDING CEREMONIES

The medal awarding ceremonies will take place in the Competition Sport Hall.

The ceremonies will take place before the anti-doping control.

The judokas reaching the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd position in every category will step on the podium to receive their medals (1 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze).

Judokas must wear the official tracksuits of their delegation during the medal awarding ceremonies. When the anthem is played and the flags raised, the judokas must face the flagpoles. They must also behave in a dignified manner throughout the ceremony (IJF rules).

The flags of the nations of judokas receiving the medals will be raised while the anthem of the winning country is being played (short version).

8. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All the athletes participating in the 2007 EYOF may be tested at all times in whatever place during the whole period of the games – from 21st to 28th of July 2007 – (random test) and/or during the competitions (competition test).

The anti-doping test will be done following the WADA rules in force during the games. All the forbidden substances included the WADA 2007 official lists are subject to detection.

At the end of the medal awarding ceremony, the athletes selected for anti-doping control will be escorted to the Anti-doping Control Centre.

Athletes who will not participate in the medal awarding ceremony, but who have been selected for anti-doping control will be escorted directly to the waiting room in the Anti-doping Control Centre.

Athletes may be escorted to the Anti-doping Control Centre by a person appointed by their delegation.

Athletes may not go to the toilet before giving the urine sample required for anti-doping control. Athletes may only drink beverages provided by Organizing Committee.

After completion of the anti-doping control procedures, the athletes may rejoin their team or go to their accommodation.

9. RESULTS

The official results will be published and distributed at the end of the each day competition and on the notice board at the EYOF Information Centre – OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE.

All the results and also the next day's programme will be made available to the delegations in the EYOF Information Centre at the OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE, as well as in the OC Secretariat office at the "NEW BELGRADE" SPORTS HALL.

The results will be published in English and Serbian.

10. ADVERTISING

No form of advertising, whether commercial or otherwise, may appear on sportswear or accessories, or on any article of clothing or equipment whatsoever used by the participants in the EYOF except for the manufacturer's logo or trademark, in conformance with IOC rules.

11. MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical assistance and first-aid will be assured by the City Medical Service. During competition one ambulance with a physician will be attendance near the competition hall.

12. DISPUTES

EJU Jury

The jury is not a jury of appeal.

It can be consulted by the referees in case of any difficulty. In no circumstances can the competitors or their representatives of their delegation consult the jury.

No protest against the referees' decisions will be accepted.

13. TRANSPORTS

A system of large capacity shuttle busses will connect the OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE and the "NEW BELGRADE" SPORTS HALL every 20 minutes.

The busses will be recognizable because they will have a panel showing the mascot at the front of the vehicle.

The busses will leave from the OLYMPIC VILLAGE - UNIVERSITY CITY NEW BELGRADE bus stop, and from the bus stop in front of the "NEW BELGRADE" SPORTS HALL.
