Competition mode:

Tournaments will be carried out according to the rules and codes of IJF/EJU, double repechage system on 3 mats.

preliminaries	3 mats (8 m x 8 m)
fight for 3rd places	2 mats (8 m x 8 m)
finals	1 mat (8 m x 8 m)

Doping control:

The Gold Medal Winner and another drawn Medalist from the rest per weight category are obliged to take a doping test.

Referees:

Each participating National Federation must be accompanied by one referee having IJF continental „A” or „B” licence but not more than 2 male referee and 1 female referee. This is a necessary condition for participating in tournaments, to meet the EJU requirements.

Special rules:

According to the qualifying system of the Olympic Games and EJU decisions the number of competitors is limited as below:

from European countries	2 competitors max. per weight categories
from non European countries	1 competitor max. per weight categories
from organizing country	4 competitor max. per weight categories

Liability:

Neither the organizers of the event nor the Hungarian Judo Association (nor any its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for arising accident or damage during of participation or traveling in connection with this championship.

Advertisements:

Regulation of EJU concerning advertisements on judogi is to be obliged. During the tournaments back numbers on the judogi provided by the organizer are allowed only. Back numbers of previous tournaments must be removed from the judogi.

In case paying the accommodation expenses after the deadline or on the spot 10 % will be added to the expenses.

Entry fee:

for participants who do not wish to have accommodation in official hotel **100** EUR/person.

Money transfers must be completed till **15th of Jan. 2008**

All bank fees and money transfer costs are to be paid by the sender federation.

Cancellation : up to 30 days before arrival: free of charge, 29-15 days before arrival : 40% refund, less than 15 days before arrival no refund.

EJU licence:

EJU rules require a payment of EUR **10** for each individual competitor participating in Hungária World Cup tournament. This amount must be paid by the National Federations for each their competitors.
