Please make payment via bank transfer before Monday **11st of February 2008**. If payment is made after this date a surcharge of 10 % will be levied upon the total payable amount. Possible reservation of extra rooms at the check-in will also be surcharged with 10 %. No exceptions will be made.

All bank fees and bank transfer costs are to be paid by the participating federation.

Cancellation fees: up to 30 days before the arrival, full refund. From 30-15 days before the arrival 50% of the payment. After the **10**<sup>th</sup> **of February 2008** any cancellations of rooms or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs. Cancellations of rooms **cannot** be made at the check-in. **Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.**

The European Judo Union has fixed participation fees for Super World Cups, to be paid on the spot: from Europe  " 10, per participant from outside Europe " 150, per participant
Remarks	Please make sure that your team arrives <b>prior to 18:00 h</b> , Thursday, February 21 <sup>st</sup> 2008 as no additional or any change of entries will be accepted after 18:00 h.
Transfer	Federations which reserve rooms in the official hotels of competition can make use of all transportation. They will be picked up at the airport or train station and after competition transferred back to the airport or train station. Federations not staying in official hotels cand use transportation.

Visa	For nations, who need VISA to enter Germany, please send us as soon as possible (latest 3rd February 2008) the list of participants with names, passport numbers, birth dates and function. Please be informed that the letter of invitation will be send by regular post. Any other request will be charged to the applicating federation (e.g. express mail service).
Attention	For good reasons sake we would like to draw your attention to the fact that the originators will be held liable to make good and repair all damages caused by the athletes or officials during their stay at Hamburg. Please, note that the hotel employees will perform a room examination prior to your checking out.
