Competition mode:

Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF / EJU, double repechage system, on 3 mats.

**Number of
athletes:**

According to the EJU decision regarding the World Cup tournaments:
European countries: 2 competitors maximum per weight category
Non European: 1 competitor maximum per weight category
Organising nation: 4 competitors maximum per weight category

Judogis:

The blue and white judogis will be obligatory.
Please note, that from the year 2006 all athletes taking part in the EJU World Cups / Super World Cups have to carry their **surname on the back of their judogi**.

Doping control:

The gold medal winner and another drawn medallist in each weight category contested have to participate in the doping control.

Referees: Maximum per country : Organizing nation: 8 referees
 Participating nation 2 male referees + 1 female referee
 Non-participating 1 referee
 Referees must be holding the IJF licence, A or B.
