1. Technical Information

1.1. DATE

The competition will be held on the 12^h, 13^h and the 14^h of September 2008.

1.2. PARTICIPATION

Each delegation may enter up to a maximum of 1 athlete per category, totalling up to 14 athletes. The athletes can only be entered in one weight category, the one in which they are enrolled.

The competitors must be of the same nationality as the country, which enters them.

Competitors who have double nationality can represent only 1 participating country.

When a competitor changes nationality, he must wait 3 years before he can represent the new country, unless the two countries concerned (the old country and the new country) agree to authorize his entry for the new nationality and this is accepted by the IJF (According to the Olympic charter Art. 46 and internal regulations point 46).

1.3. AGE

-20 years girls and boys (born 1989 - 1993)

Note: During the Congress held in 1998, it was approved that athletes under the age of 15 years of age are not allowed to compete at any EJU championship.

Therefore, during these championships, no athletes born after 1993.

are allowed to participate.

1.4. WEIGHT CATEGORIES

Weights: -44 kg; -48 kg; -52 kg; -57 kg; -63 kg; -70 kg; -78 kg; +78 kg

Weights: -55 kg; -60 kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100 kg

1.5. INSCRIPTION

Numerical inscriptions

The numerical inscriptions, Form 1, must arrive at the EJU secretariat about two months before the start of the competition. (See Annex 1 for the deadline)

Nominal inscriptions

The nominative inscriptions must be entered into JUMAS. The JUMAS entry closes Monday of the weeks before the championships. (See Annex 2 for the deadline)

The federations must pay an entry fee per competitor, the moment they make the numerical entry.

The inscription fee is 100 Euro per participating competitor, to be paid to:

All payments entered after the inscriptions deadline will be 125 Euro per competitor.

1.6. COMPETITION FORMULA

The System of Competition will be the elimination system with double repechage, i.e. for all categories the contestants will be divided into two tables by means of a draw, and an elimination system will be used to produce two finalists.

(See extract from IJF SOR in annex for more information)

The competition of each category will take place on one day.

The order of the categories is as follows:

1st day

women: -44 kg / -48 kg / -52 kg men: -55 kg / -60 kg / -66 kg

2nd day

-57 kg / -63 kg / -70 kg women:

-73 kg / -81kg men:

3rd day women:

-78 kg / +78 kg

-90 kg / -100 kg / +100 kg men:

1.7. DURATION OF CONTESTS

The duration of each contest will be that of 4 minutes for juniors men and women.

1.8. WEIGH IN

The weigh-in takes place on the same morning between 07:00hrs and 07:30hrs, as the competition for the category concerned. Unofficial weigh-in takes place between 06:30hrs and 07:00hrs.

The weight of the fighters has to fall within the category in which they are enrolled.

The fighters:

- Presenting themselves after the closing of the weigh-in, cannot participate at the competition.
- Can present themselves only one time at the official weigh-in.
- Must present their EJU accreditation and an official piece of identity (identity card or passport) at the official weigh-in.

Please refer to program for exact time of weigh in.

1.9. **DRAW**

The draw will take place at 20:00hrs at the Congress Hall, Hotel Novotel, the eve before the first day of fights after the nation control.

The top 4 (four) competitors in each weight category from the EJU Junior Ranking List 2008 will be seeded.

Note: before the draw the lists of each category are hung in the draw room / in the corridor outside the draw room. Each head of delegation should check that all his inscribed athletes are on these lists and that they are under the right category. No corrections can be made after the draw.

1.10. CONTROL OF NATIONS

The federations must be in order with the annual fee and other financial obligations to the EJU.

The entry fee per competitor must be paid to the EJU.

In order to take part at the competition the national federation must have fulfilled the necessary payments to the organizer and the EJU.

If fewer competitors participate at the competition than the number of participants entered by the federation, the surplus paid entry fee will be taken into credit for the following event on behalf of the concerned federation.

Control of Nations

Identity: Nationality and age of the participants. (each athlete's passport has to be presented to the EJU official. The competitors must not be present at the nation control.)

List of entries: The list of entries is confirmed with the EJU official.

No inscription will be accepted after the end of the nation control.

Accreditation C.

A list of all the inscribed athletes is generated by the JUMAS system, which is confirmed by the head of delegation that it is the final list.

The EJU accreditation cards, which are printed from JUMAS, must be presented at the official weigh-in and before each fight.

1.11. CLOTHING

The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi.

Each federation must bring spare judogi. These judogi, wearing the back number of the competition, will be kept near the tatami during the competition.

NOTE: all competitors participating at the European Championships have to carry their surname on the judogi (see handbook "Judogi")

The women competitors must wear a white non-transparent T-shirt, The bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair has to be bound with an elastic band.

Make-up and jewellery are prohibited.

The nails have to be cut short.

1.12. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FEDERATIONS

Medical certificate

The sex certificate and the medical certificate of the fighters are not required.

The fighters will compete under the full responsibility of the federations.

Insurance

Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against « injury and third part risk (public liability) » during the period of the championships.

The European Judo Union declines all responsibility.

f. Attitude of the competitors

The member-federations are responsible vis-à-vis the EJU concerning the general attitude of their fighters.

2. Anti-Doping (extracts from EJU Medical Handbook)

2.1. SELECTION OF ATHLETES

The Gold Medal Winner and another Drawn Medallist from the rest (TWO tests PER WEIGHT CATEGORY contested)

2.2. SELECTION OF ATHLETES

The summons for the doping test is handed by an escort or EJU doctor to the competitor selected to the doping control immediately after the athlete comes out of tatami. The escort writes the time on the form. The athlete must sign the form and have a copy. The escort gives the original one to the doping control staff, who records the actual time of arrival on the summons, signs it and verifies the identity of the competitor (ID card, passport...). The Athlete has to register by maximum 60 min. after he/she has signed the notification form (including press) at the doping control station. The escort has to be physically beside the competitor and keep the competitor under observation (visible) all the time and accompany her/him to the waiting room at the Doping Control Station (DCS). Interruption of the doping control procedure is allowed only for victory ceremonies. During the interruption the athletes have to be under observation of the escorts at all times. A person may accompany the competitor to the Doping Control Station and may watch all procedures except urination.

2.3. SAMPLE TAKING PROCEDURE

Only one competitor at a time shall be called into the test room (=working room, consulting area). The competitor shall select by her/himself an urine collection vessel, check it and proceed to the toilet and urinate a minimum of 75 ml into the collection vessel under observation of the Doping Control Officer who must be of the same gender as the competitor. Any clothing preventing the direct observation of the urination shall be removed.

When requested urine volume of 75 ml (minimum) has been provided, the competitor shall select a urine control kit, open and check it and pour by her/himself 25 ml (minimum) first into bottle B and then 50 ml (minimum) into bottle A. Few drops of urine shall remain in the collection vessel to check specific gravity and pH. The competitor shall close the A and B bottles hermetically. The remaining urine is to be destroyed after sealing of bottles A and B.

If the amount of urine is less than 75 ml, partial sample kit or temporary sealing is needed.

The specific gravity must be 1.010 or higher and pH 5.0 - 7.0.

If not, another sample is needed.

If specific gravity of the first sample is 1.005, but less than 1.010, urine is needed 110 ml (70 ml into bottle A and 40 ml into bottle B) for the second sample.

If specific gravity of the first sample is under 1.005 or pH is not between the limits, a further sample of minimum 150 ml is needed.

No more than two (2) samples are to be taken during the doping test.

The competitor shall declare any medications, vitamins, herbal products, food supplements that were ingested in the previous 7 days.

The competitor shall certify, by signing the protocol form, that the procedure has been performed according to the rules of EJU. Any irregularities e.g. problems to keep order etc. identified by the competitor, accompanying person, officers or EJU doctor shall be recorded

The Doping Control Officer, accompanying person (if present) and EJU doctor (if present and seen the whole procedure) sign the Doping Control Record.

The competitor shall be given a copy of the Form, and EJU doctor an original or a copy of the form.

After the test procedure he/she and the accompanying person must leave the station.

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3. Refereeing

3.1. LEVEL OF THE REFEREES

The contests will be refereed by Continental and International Referees ranked in the JUNIOR Group (J) by the EJU Refereeing Commission for the year 2008.

3.2. INSCRIPTIONS

The number of referees per federation is limited to:

Participating countries may enter 2 Referees.

Non participating countries may enter 1 Referee.

The organizing country may enter 3 Referees.

The EJU REF COM may limit the number of Referees according the entries.

Each participating federation has to enter at least one referee.

Only the referees entered by their federation can referee.

The costs for travelling, board and lodging of the referees are at the costs of the member federation.

Inscriptions have to be sent to the EJU General Secretariat & entered in JUMAS not later than 2 weeks before the championships. For the exact date, please check Annex 2.

An inscription form is enclosed as Form 3.

3.3. REFEREE MEETING

A referee meeting is scheduled the evening before the first competition day at 19:00hrs, on the 11th of September 2008 at 19:00hrs at the Hotel Novotel.

The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory.

If an entered referee does not present himself, his federation can be imposed of a penalty according to the list of penalties of the EJU (dated 28.4.1982).

3.4. REFEREEING RULES

The refereeing rules are the IJF and EJU rules.

It's obligatory to take a decision at the end of each fight.

For each contest, three referees will be appointed who will not be of the same nationality as either of the competitors.

EJU Jury

The jury is not an appeals jury.

It can be consulted by the referees in case of any difficulty. In no circumstances can the competitors or their representatives of their delegation consult the jury.

No protest against the referees' decisions will be accepted.

Withdrawal by injury:

During eliminations

- if the responsibility of the injury cannot be attributed to one of the fighters, the injured fighter shall loose the contest.
- if the responsibility of the injury is attributed to one of the fighters, the other will be declared winner. The fighter responsible for the injury will not be able to participate at the repechages.
- In case of withdrawal, the fighters cannot present himself for the following fights.

During the finals or semi-finals

- if the responsibility of the injury cannot be attributed to one of the fighters, the injured fighter shall loose
- if the responsibility of the injury is attributed to one of the fighters, the other will be declared winner.

Note: a fighter who has been declared as a looser by injury can continue the competition. A fighter who has got a direct « hansokumake » will not be authorised to continue the competition.

3.5. JUDOGI CONTROL

The judogi will be controlled by the national referees of the organising country:

- 1. The day before the competition before the back numbers are sewn to the judogi for verification of the conformity of the publicity and markings.
- 2. On the day of the competition before the fights for the control of the back numbers, dimensions and conformity of the judogi and equipment used by the fighters.
