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1. Technical Information – Individual

1.1. DATE

The competition will be held on the 13th, 14th and the 15th of November 2008.

1.2. PARTICIPATION

Each federation affiliated with the European Judo Union may enter as many athletes as it desires. Each athlete can be entered only in one weight category, the one in which they are enrolled.

The competitors must be of a minimum of 30 years of age and not been participating in any international competition for a minimum of 2 years, such as i.e. WC, SWC, EC, WCC or the OG. The responsibility to respect this rule is on the National Federation which will release the competitor list respecting this rule.

The competitors must be of the same nationality as the country, which enters them.

Competitors who have double nationality can only represent 1 participating country. When a competitor changes nationality, he must wait 1 year before he can represent the new country, unless the two countries concerned (the old country and the new country) agree to authorize his entry for the new nationality.

1.4. WEIGHT CATEGORIES

Women

Weights: -48 kg ; -52 kg ; -57 kg ; -63 kg ; -70 kg ; -78 kg ; +78 kg

Men

Weights: -60 kg ; -66 kg ; -73 kg ; -81 kg ; -90 kg ; -100 kg ; +100 kg

The Organizers / EJU Sports Director can combine a category with the next category if the number of participants in a category is not sufficient. In this case, the medal awarded is that of the higher category.

1.5. INSCRIPTION

Numerical inscriptions

The numerical inscriptions must arrive at the EJU secretariat and the organizers about two months before the start of the competition (see Annex 2 for the deadline and the address of the EJU Secretariat can be found in Annex 4. Please use Form 1 for the numerical inscription).



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Nominal inscriptions

The nominal inscriptions must be entered into JUMAS and Forms 3 sent to organizers. The JUMAS entry closes on the 29th October 2008. (See Annex 2 for the deadlines)

All participants need to have a JUMAS membership card (25€ valid for 5 years), which are ordered exclusively by National Federations.

Entry fee

The federations or competitors must pay an entry fee per competitor, the moment they make the nominal inscription. The entry fee is 100 Euro per participating competitor and has to be paid to the organizers before 29th October 2008.

A return of the entry fee is not possible.

No entries are possible after the 12th November 2008 at 17:00 hours !

1.6. COMPETITION FORMULA

The System of Competition used will be:

Round-robin in the case of 3 or 4 athletes in one category

Elimination system with double repechage will be used for 5 or more competitors.

For 2 or less athletes, the category will be joined to the closer age category at the discretion of the EJU sports director.

The competition of each category will take place on one day.

The order of the age groups is as follows:

<u>1st day</u>	F5; F6 M5; M6; M7
<u>2nd day</u>	F1; F2 M1; M2
<u>3rd day</u>	F3; F4 M3; M4

Preliminaries will be held on 6 mats, the fight for the bronze medals on 2 mats and the finals on 1 mat. EJU Sports Director can change the numeral of mats if it is found necessary or for the benefit of the competition.

1.7. WEIGH IN

The weigh-in takes place on the evening before the competition between 16:00 and 19:00hrs, as the competition for the category concerned.

The weight of the fighters has to fall within the category in which they are enrolled.

The fighters:

- Presenting themselves after the closing of the weigh-in, cannot participate at the competition.
- Must present their EJU accreditation and an official piece of identity (identity card or passport) at the official weigh-in.

The weigh in will be held at the Hotel DUO.

1.8. DRAW

The draw will take place the evening before the day the category is played.

The two finalists and the four medallists of the European Championships of the previous year will be seeded.



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Note: before the draw, the lists of each category are hung in the draw room / in the corridor outside the draw room and each head of delegation should check that all his inscribed athletes are on these lists and that they are under the right category. No corrections can be made after the draw.

1.9. CONTROL OF NATIONS

a. Finances

The federations must be in order with the annual fee and other financial obligations to the EJU. In order to take part at the competition, the national federation must have fulfilled the necessary payments to the organizer and the EJU.

b. Control of Nations

Identity: Nationality and age of the participants (each athlete's passport (or a copy) has to be presented to the EJU official. the competitors must not be present at the nation control).

List of entries: The list of entries is confirmed with the EJU official. No inscription will be accepted after the end of the nation control.

c. Accreditation

A list of all the inscribed athletes is generated by the EJU Competition system, which is confirmed by the head of delegation that it is the final list.

The EJU accreditation cards, which are printed from JUMAS, must be presented at the official weigh in and before each fight .

1.10. CLOTHING

The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi.

Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations and previous back numbers must be removed.

The competitors can use ONE privat sponsor name (logo) on the judogi according to IJF standards.

There will be no back numbers for this competition.

Long hair has to be bound with an elastic band. Nails have to be cut short.

The women competitors must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. The bras must not have any hard pieces. Make-up and jewellery are prohibited.

1.11. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FEDERATIONS

d. Medical certificate

The sex certificate and the medical certificate of the fighters are not required.

The fighters will compete under the full responsibility of the federations.

e. Insurance

Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against «injury and third part risk (public liability)» during the period of the championships.

The European Judo Union declines all responsibility.

f. Attitude of the competitors

The member-federations are responsible vis-à-vis the EJU concerning the general attitude of their fighters.

1.12. ANTI-DOPING

No anti-doping control tests are done during the European Championships.



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1. Technical Information – Teams

1.1. DATE

The competition will be held on the **16th of November 2008**.

1.2. PARTICIPATION

The team should consist of 5 players. 1 substitute is authorised per each weight category. All the players should have not participated in official national or EJU competitions during the last 2 years. In order to be represented, the team must be composed of at least 3 competitors who can compete in 3 different weight categories. Only the National Judo Federation can enter teams (unlimited number of teams).

The competitors must be of the same nationality as the country, which enters them. Competitors who have double nationality can only represent only 1 participating country. When a competitor changes nationality, he must wait 1 year before he can represent the new country, unless the two countries concerned (the old country and the new country) agree to authorize his entry for the new nationality.

1.3. CONTEST DURATION

The duration of each contest will be that of 3 minutes for men and for women.

1.4. WEIGHT and AGE

The competition is divided into 3 age categories:

The competitors must be of at least 30 years of age in the year of the competition (born 1978 and before). Athlete can be entered in the age division immediately below the division he belongs to. However, the athlete can be entered only in one team.

The categories to be contested are:

Male: -66, -73,-81,-90, over 90 kg

Female: -52,-57,-63,-70, over 70kg

Athletes will be entered during the weigh-in in the category they belong to. However, they can compete in the category immediately above their own category.

1.5. INSCRIPTION

Numerical inscriptions

The numerical inscriptions must arrive at the EJU secretariat and the organizers about two months before the start of the competition (see Annex 2 for the deadline and the address of the EJU Secretariat can be found in Annex 4. Please use Form 2 for the numerical inscription - teams).



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Nominal inscriptions

The nominal inscriptions must be sent to the EJU secretariat **and** copied to the organizers not later than 29th October 2008. (Form 2, see Annex 2 for the deadlines).

ALL ENTRIES SHOULD ALSO BE REGISTERED IN JUMAS AND ALL PARTICIPANTS HAVING A JUMAS MEMBERSHIP (25€ valid for 5 years). The deadline for the JUMAS registration is 29 October 2008.

Entry fee

The federations must pay an entry fee per team the moment they make the nominal inscriptions.

The entry fee is 300€ per participating team and has to be paid to the organizers before the 29th of October 2008.

A return of the entry fee is not possible.

No entries are possible after the 15th of November 2008 at 17.00 hours!

1.6. COMPETITION FORMULA

The competitions will be held on double repechage system. Semi finals and finals will take place on the same day. There will be 2 bronze medallists / for both men & women /.

The competitions will be held in the following order: from the lightest to the heaviest weight category.

The player in reserve can be entered to compete at any moment and can be replaced again without any restrictions. Before each fight, the team gives its entry with possible corrections.

match is decided by the number of fights won. If equal, then the higher score of technical points.

1.7. WEIGH IN

The official weigh-in takes place on the evening before the competition day between 16:00hrs and 19:00hrs.

Athletes who do their weigh in for the Individual European Veteran Championships and compete on Thursday - Saturday 13th, 14th and 15th of November 2008 do not need to weigh in again. The same weight category will be used.

The fighters:

- Presenting themselves after the closing of the weigh-in, cannot participate at the competition.
- Must present their EJU accreditation and an official piece of identity (identity card or passport) at the official weigh-in.

The weigh in will be held at the Hotel DUO.

1.8. DRAW

The draw will take place on evening before the competition after Weigh In at 20:00hrs at the Hotel DUO.

Note: before the draw the lists of each team are hung in the draw room / in the corridor outside the draw room. Each head of delegation should check that all his inscribed athletes are on these lists and that they are under the right category. No corrections can be made after the draw.

1.9. CONTROL OF NATIONS

a. Finances

The federations must be in order with the annual fee and other financial obligations to the EJU.

In order to take part at the competition the national federation must have fulfilled the necessary payments to the organizer and the EJU.



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b. Control of Nations

Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against «injury and third part risk (public liability)» during the period of the championships.

The European Judo Union declines all responsibility.

f. Attitude of the competitors

The member-federations are responsible vis-à-vis the EJU concerning the general attitude of their fighters.

1.12. ANTI-DOPING

No anti-doping control tests are done during the European Championships.



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2. Refereeing

2.1. LEVEL OF THE REFEREES

The contests will be refereed by Continental and International Referees ranked in the **A**, **B** or **C** Group by the EJU Refereeing Commission for the year 2008. National A licensed Referees are allowed.

2.2. INSCRIPTIONS

The number of referees per federation is unlimited. The EJU REF COM may limit the number of Referees according the entries.

Each participating federation has to enter at least one referee.

Only the referees entered by their federation can referee.

The costs for travelling, board and lodging of the referees are at the costs of the member federation.

Inscriptions have to be sent to the EJU General Secretariat & entered in JUMAS not later than 2 weeks before the championships (see Annex 2 for exact date). An inscription form is enclosed as Form 3.

2.3. REFEREE MEETING

A referee meeting is scheduled the evening before the first competition day, at the Hotel DUO on the 12th November 2008 at 19:00hrs. **The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory.**

If an entered referee does not present himself, his federation can be imposed of a penalty according to the list of penalties of the EJU (dated 28.04.1982).

2.4. REFEREEING RULES

The refereeing rules are the IJF and EJU rules.

It's obligatory to take a decision at the end of each fight.

For each contest, three referees will be appointed who will not be of the same nationality as either of the competitors.

EJU Jury

The jury is not an appeals jury.

It can be consulted by the referees in case of any difficulty. In no circumstances can the competitors or their representatives of their delegation consult the jury.

No protest against the referees' decisions will be accepted.

Withdrawal by injury:

During eliminations

- If the responsibility of the injury cannot be attributed to one of the fighters, the injured fighter shall loose the contest.

- If the responsibility of the injury is attributed to one of the fighters, the other will be declared winner. The fighter responsible for the injury will not be able to participate at the repechages.

- In case of withdrawal, the fighters cannot present himself for the following fights.

During the finals or semi-finals

- If the responsibility of the injury cannot be attributed to one of the fighters, the injured fighter shall loose the contest.

- If the responsibility of the injury is attributed to one of the fighters, the other will be declared winner.

Note: A fighter who has been declared as a loser by injury can continue the competition. A fighter who has got a direct «hansokumake» as the penalty against the spirit of our sport, will not be authorised to continue the competition.

2.5. JUDOGI CONTROL

The judogi will be controlled by the national referees of the organizing country on the day of the competition before the fights for the control of the back numbers, dimensions and conformity of the judogi and equipment used by the fighters.

3.1. ACCREDITATIONS PER DELEGATION (Federation)

Two types of accreditations will be issued:

A) Accreditation of athletes and coaches with access to the mats. Number of accreditations is not limited.

B) Fan Club.

Referees, officials without access to the mats, video, masseurs, family members, friends, supporters, etc.

NOTE: Only persons accommodated in the official hotels can be accredited, with no exception.
