The departure date is the same for all wrestlers - July 19th.

Any extra day required to be settled payment at the wrestler. The hotel only covers the night of stay and breakfast for the next morning on the service dates for qualified 96 wrestlers and 13 IFS officials. Other expenses, such as telephone bill, paid TV, mini-bar and laundry, are not covered by organizer and individual shall be responsible for these expenses.

# 9. ENTRY AND PROCEDURE – CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

- Participants shall be from Member Countries of the International Sumo Federation and Countries approved by the IFS.
- > The participating countries must be registered with the International Sumo Federation.
- ➤ A Sumo wrestler may participate in the competition only under the nationality appearing on her passport.

#### 11. AIRFARE

Travel Expenses – The cost of airfare for all participating from the participating country to Kaohsiung airport, Chinese Taipei will be borne by that participating country.

For arrivals, wrestlers from Asian countries are scheduled to arrive on July 15<sup>th</sup>. Wrestlers from other continents (travel more than 8 hours flights) are scheduled to arrive on July 14<sup>th</sup>. The departure date is the same for all wrestlers - July 19th.

#### 12. ACCREDITATION

#### **Accreditation:**

The delegations will be accredited upon their arrival in Kaohsiung. To be informed on the actual pick up location.

The accreditation is personal, non transferable and compulsory to have access to the training and competition halls as well as for the official transportation system of the Organizing Committee.

The accreditation identifies individuals participating in the event and indicates their right to access to the different zones.

Controls will be made at the entrance to each area. All participants are required to wear the ID card at any time in the competition venue.

At the accreditation, the heads of delegation are requested to check the names of the delegation members, verify accommodation requirements, make the necessary payments.

The organizer (KOC) will copy all competitors and judges passports for proof of identity, control of Nationality and age as well as for anti-doping purposes.

# 13. INSURANCE

Medical Health and Accident Insurance – "This is required by the IWGA Rules."

- (1) Proof of health and accident insurance policy (including medical coverage) for every participant is mandatory by the IWGA Rules and will be checked upon arrival prior to the accreditation.
- (2) Any individual who is unable to present the insurance proof for checking shall purchase the insurance at the accreditation center to receive the full rights of participation.

Secretary General of each National Federation shall help IFS to check the proof in advance and put a mark on the system.

### 14. COACHES'S MEETING AND TOURNAMENT DRAWING

Coaches 'Meeting and Tournament drawing will be held at 14:00 – 15:00 on July 16 at arena.

#### 15. REFEREE MEETING

Referee session will be held at 15:00 -16:00 on July 16 at arena.

### 16. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

The Opening will take place on Friday July 17th 2009 at 14.20 pm in the Competition Hall. All national flags will be presented by local volunteers.

#### 19. COMPETITION ATTIRE

- Mawashi approved by the International Sumo Federation must be worn.
- The underpants must be in BLACK color ONLY, other colors are not allowed. The length of the underpants must cover the whole thigh.
- Mawashi and underpants shall be supplied by the wrestlers (brought with them).

## 20. JUDGES' INSTRUCTION AND BRIEFINGS

- A judging panel shall consist of a head judge, a *gyoji* (referee) and four judges for a total of 6 members.
- The head judge is entirely responsible for determining the result of a bout.
- The *gyoji* assumes control of a bout from the time when the competitors mount the *dohyo* until they step down from the *dohyo* upon completion of the bout.

- The duties of the four judges are to assist the head judge to ensure that there are no errors in the decision.
- The shomen (front) judge shall also function as the timekeeper.

### 21. JUDGES' PANELS AND JURY OF APPEAL

- The head judge and judges shall wear suits, white shirts and ties. (If the International Sumo Federation designates a particular jacket, pants or tie, these shall be worn.)
- The gyoji shall wear white pants, white shirt and a black bow tie

#### 22. SEATING FOR THE DELEGATIONS

Nearby Dohyo. (Exact location to be decided) Reserved seating will be allocated to VIPs and media staff.

# 23. TICKETING - NON ACCREDITED OFFICIALS / GUESTS

- 1. Tickets will be sold through i-bon system at 4,800 7-ELEVEN Convenient Stores in Taiwan, and can be purchased and collected in stores.
- A bilingual (Chinese and English) ticketing website will be opened for ticket pre-sale in the beginning of April 2009. Tickets are collectable at ticket booths at competition venues.
- 3. Two types of tickets will be presented: Day Pass and Package Ticket.
  - Day Pass: It can be used for all day of any given sport.
  - Package Ticket: It is valid throughout all competition schedule of any given sport.

### 24. PUBLICATION OF RESULT

The detailed result will be published on the screen in the competition hall.

#### 25. MEDICAL SERVICES

#### MEDICAL SERVICES

(1) Each venue has at least one First-Aid Station, consisting of 1 doctor, 2 nurse, 2 EMT medical dispatch personnel from the Emergency Department of Fire Bureau, 2 volunteers and 1 ambulance on site in the venue.

- (2) No oral medicine provided in venues.
- (3) Hospitalization due to competition-related injury:
- (4) Injured athletes or working staff should be accompanied by teammates or reception volunteers to the hospitals. Before leaving hospitals, the injured should pay for medical fees (NT cash only) and take receipts as well as diagnosis certificate for insurance compensation.
- (5) (4) First-Aid station is set up 30 minutes before the competition and removed after the end of the game.
- (6) (5) Under the circumstance of companion with the official team doctor, the team doctor is the main one in charge of injured athletes, and the medical personnel serves as the assistant who stand by on doctors' demand.
- (7) (6) After completely medical treatment, the whole process should be recorded in the medical record form. If athletes get so seriously injured that they may be advised to quit the game by doctors, it depends on the final decision of athletes or coaches that whether they insist to continue the game or not. If they decide to continue, there should be an agreement released by referees and signed by athletes.

All chiropractic treatments and sports taping must only be performed by the FICS and Athletic Trainers under the consent and request from the athlete, the head of delegation or the couch. Any sports injury that requires doctor's prescription or intrusive medical treatment will be referred to the first aid medical team of the KOC.

#### 26. DOPING CONTROLS

#### **Authority to test**

Pursuant to the IWGA Anti-Doping Rules, all athletes participating in The World Games shall be subject to In-Competition Testing for the duration between their official registration at the Games and the Closing Ceremony of the Games. The authority to conduct and perform testing is with International World Games Association (IWGA), Kaohsiung Organizing Committee and Chinese Taipei Anti-Doping Agency (CTADA) affiliated to Chinese Taipei Olympic Committee.

The chair of IWGA Medical Committee or his/her representative is responsible to oversee all Anti-Doping Testing during the World Games.

## **Testing Standards**

The testing conducted during the 8<sup>th</sup> World Games Kaohsiung under supervision of IWGA Medical Committee shall be in conformity with the International Standard for Testing in force at the time of testing.

#### **Doping Control Center**

The doping control center will be established in accordance with the instruction and guidelines of IWGA Medical Committee.

# **Analysis of Samples**

All samples of athletes will be collected based on the doping control procedures in accordance with International Standard for Testing, and will be analyzed in a WADA-accredited laboratory, in this case, the laboratory in Tokyo, Japan shall apply.

# **Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)**

Any participating athlete requires a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) shall file the application together with medical documents required to IWGA Medical Committee for approval twenty-one (21) days before the Games.

# **Governing Rules**

The IWGA Anti-Doping Rules shall be applicable during the World Games, whereas the World Anti-Doping Code shall apply.

Doping Control Guide for World Games approved by the IWGA Medical Committee will be available for all participating delegations before their departure for the Games. Test Distribution Planning will be elaborated by the IWGA Medical Committee, which shall be followed by CTADA under the authority of IWGA and Kaohsiung Organizing Committee.

#### **27. IMPORTANT NOTES**

Accreditation can only be done through IFS.
