# OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM AND INVITATION

The European Sumo Union and the Sumo Federation of Switzerland would like to invite your Federation to participate in the European Sumo Championships 2009 in Renens, Switzerland.

#### 01. Title of event:

The 15<sup>th</sup> Men and Women, 8<sup>th</sup> Men and Women under 21 years (Mu21/Wu21), 5<sup>th</sup> Junior under 18 years (Mu18/Wu18) and 2<sup>nd</sup> Cadets Boys and Girls (Bu16/Gu16) European Sumo Championships 2009.

#### 02. Objective:

To develop Sumo within Europe and to and exchange social and cultural ties among participating countries.

# **03.** Main organiser:

Swiss Sumo Society

**04. Date of competition**:  $21^{st} - 23^{rd}$  August 2009

**05.** Competition venue. Odyssée Sports Hall, Patinoire de Malley, Renens, Switzerland

06. Registration address and accreditation: Patinoire de Malley, Renens, Switzerland

# 07. Participation:

All Member Federations registered to the European Sumo Union may participate so long as the annual membership fee of €150 to the ESU has paidfor the year 2009 by the time of registrations and that there are no other outstanding payments due to the ESU in any form whatsoever. Please note also that federations not attending with at least one Sumo referee will be charged a penalty fee of €100 this must be paid at the accreditation. At the time of accreditation the participating federation must state on which days their referee(s) will be active. If a federation registers a referee in order to avoid the €100 europayment and the referee fails to attend then this

may lead to a further penalty fee as to be decided by the board of Directors of the ESU, failure to comply with this rule may lead to non participation of the said federation until such payments have been received by the ESU.

**08. Media accreditation:** To be issued by the Swiss Sumo Society

#### 09. Registration of athletes

- Dates and registration requirements as for the athletes: mentioned in point 12.
- Accommodation and sustenance expenses as for the athletes: mentioned in point 11.
- The entry fee per athlete per weight category is U16, U18 and U21: € 25, Seniors: €50 and for the Team event: €100 per team, upon payment thisfee is non returnable.
- If after the closing date Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2009 at 17.00 C.E.T there are any changes whatsoever to the athletes registrations, change of athlete, late entry, change of athlete in team position then a double entry fee will be charged. If athletes are cancelled after the closing date the entry fee has to be paid and will not be refunded. All outstanding amounts must be paid full in cash before admittance to the championships will be granted to the ESU Treasurer. All entries must be sent to the General Secretary of the European Sumo Union at the following e-mail address ozumo@telenet.be

#### **10. Travel Expenses:**

Each individual Federation is responsible for the all travel costs incurred in the transportation of its delegation including visa applications. All Federations requiring visas are kindly requested to apply well in advance.

## 12. Registration requirements for the tournament.

**a.** The attached competition application forms are to be filled in with capital letters and to be sent to the address of the European Sumo Union e-mail or post. Entries will only be accepted on official

entry forms. Uncompleted forms will not be accepted.

- **b.** Please send one passport style photo of each delegation member in jpg format to the following email address: <a href="mailto:eurosumochamp2009@hotmail.com">eurosumochamp2009@hotmail.com</a> . Each photograph must be named following this mode: First Name–FAMILY NAME.jpg. These photos are for accreditation purposes and people arriving who have not sent their photo beforehand will have to be personally present with their passport to receive an accreditation card.
- **c.** The initial application deadline is 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2009 here you must send an intention that your federation wishes to compete. The final application deadline for athlete participation is **17<sup>th</sup> August 2009.** All countries must register for all athletes, officials to the European Sumo Championships 2009 by the above mentioned application date.
- **d.** Site of accreditation, Congress, Draw, Weigh-in: Patinoire de Malley, Renens, Switzerland For the accreditation only the delegation leader is requested to be present (except for point 12b). Please also note that the weigh-in for all groups is the evening prior to the day of the tournament including open and team event.
- e. Referee Seminar: Friday, August 21st, 08.30 h Patinoire de Malley, Renens, Switzerland
- **g.** All entries will only be accepted on the official ESU entry forms (there will be no exceptions) and must arrive by the official closing dates.
- h. At the official control of nations the names submitted are final and all fees paid at this time are not returnable whatsoever. If your delegation leader is not available to attend at this date and time then the last athlete change will be accepted by email until 17.00 hrs C.E.T 17<sup>th</sup> August 2009 to the office of the Gen Sec of the ESU e mail ozumo@telenet.be

  Names for the open event men and women plus the team sheets must be submitted before the close of the senior weigh in 22nd august 2009. Please note all athletes competing in the open and team events must attend the weigh in. Failure to do so will result in the non participation of the athlete from said categories. For the team and Open event no charge for changes will be made up until the close of the weigh in.

#### **14.** Competition rules:

- **14.1** The competition will carry out according to the ESU regulations together with application of the double repèchage system. If there are 5 or less athletes in a weight group a pool system maybe used.
- **14.2.** All male athletes will wrestle in **MAWASHI ONLY**! this includes the prize awarding ceremonies.
- **14.3.** All female athletes must wrestle in a one-piece wrestling leotard plus Mawashi.

Women may not compete wearing t-shirts.

**14.4** All mawashi must conform to international regulations, if not, it is possible that the mawashi will be invalid for the tournament and another mawashi may have to be used by the wrestler, at the discretion of the refereeing director a suitable substitute mawashi cannot be found and used within a reasonable amount of time the athlete may have to forfeit the match. Also all mawashi must be dry and not wet and made of recognised fabric.

# 15. Financial requirements:

# 15.1. Starting fee:

Entry fee will be charged for all athletes mentioned in the official entry form!

**Boys and Girls u16, \leq25 Euro**per wrestler in each weight category paid to ESU at registration and accreditation 20<sup>th</sup> August 2009.

**Juniors Mu18/Wu18, Mu21/Wu21, €25 Euro**per wrestler in each weight category paid to ESU at registration and accreditation 20<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> August 2009. If an athlete competes in maximum 2 weight groups for instance U18 and U21 or U16 and U18 then the entry fee is €50 Euro

**Seniors** € 50 Euro per wrestler in each weight group.

**Team tournament**, there is also a fee of  $\leq$  100 per team entered in the team tournament competition. These fees once paid are non returnable.

**15.2 ESU membership fee**: If the registration fee of €150 Euro per Federation for the current year 2009 has not been paid also any other outstanding amounts to the ESU, registration and entrance to the European Sumo Championships and Congress 2009 will not be allowed until such payment has been made.

# 15.3 Payment for the Senior Open weight and team competition must be paid for at the official accreditation.

**16.** As Switzerland has a high ecology friendly policy, all participants staying in a hotel in the Lausanne area will receive a free public transport pass for the duration of their stay. It is therefore strongly recommended that all participants first go to their hotel(s) before coming to the sports hall for accreditation. For people travelling by plane to Geneva Airport, it is possible to reserve preferential price train tickets for Renens and return. These cost 28 Euros per person. Please let us know how many tickets you will need and the time of arrival. People using this method will be met at

Renens station by a bus that will take them to their hotel(s). People travelling to Renens or Lausanne by train should also let us their arrival time and they will also be met at the station.

#### 17. Control of Nations and accreditation

There must be at least one representative from every Federation to register their athletes at the sport's hall from 9h00 to 18h00 on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2009 or Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2009. This must be duly signed for. Failure to register in the allocated time will mean that the Federation will not be able to participate in the European Sumo Championships 2009. It is not necessary that the participants be present (except for those who have not sent a photo beforehand!) but there must be someone who has the authority to register the nation. After this registration except for the Open Weight, the entries are final and cannot be altered.

#### 18. Health Insurance and Anti-Doping

Each federation is obliged to insure all athletes and officials against sickness, injury or death. Neither the organising country nor the European Sumo Union will be responsible for any sickness, injury or death of any athlete or official incurred before, during and after the ESC 2009. All athletes will have to sign an injury disclaimer plus a disclaimer that they have not taken any forbidden substances. For under age (u18/u16) participants the leader of the athlete's national delegation must countersign the document to certify that the parents have agreed on the participation of their child in the ESC 2009.

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted during the championships. Athletes will be randomly selected for testing, both before competitions (at weigh-in for example) and also after medal ceremonies. Any athlete discovered positive will be signalled to the ESU disciplinary commission. Any athlete refusing to sign the forbidden substances document or refusing to undergo these anti-doping controls when requested to will be automatically considered **positive**!

#### **SPECIAL NOTE**

- \*All visa applications must be sent first to the Swiss Sumo Society.
- \*Tournament registration only to be sent to the European Sumo Union.
- \*Compulsory Referee seminar on 21<sup>st</sup> August 2009. All referees must obtain here their ESC tournament licence 2009. Fee € 20 to be paid to therefereeing director,
- \*By the control of nations there has to be at least one representative from the registering Federation.
- \*By the draw there has to be one representative per federation, after the draw has been made there can be no changes.

Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2009 Departure of national delegations

**Team competition (Senior Men and Women only):** Men and Women consisting of open weight, each 3 wrestlers plus one reserve. A reserve wrestler may only be used once, after this there can be no further changes in the team. For the team event there must be a minimum of two wrestlers. Please note for the team event the fighting order will be controlled during the entrance to the dohyo all athletes competing in the team event must be able to proof their identity if approached by a controlling official.

A maximum of two athletes in each weight and age group may be entered per country. Only one national federation per country may enter the championships.

Prizes: The Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners will receive medals and diplomas.

#### Remarks

- 1. There are Team and Open Category competitions only in Senior MEN and Senior WOMEN
- 2. Competition starts always with women first in all weight categories from Lightweight upwards.
- 3. Repêchage in each weight category will start immediately after the elimination rounds.
- 4. Awarding Ceremony will be held immediately after each age category.
- 5. Athletes need only to weigh-in once if competing in two age categories on the same day. They must announce at their weigh-in the second competition in which they are competing if on the same day. Athletes who have not announced their double participation will be will be deleted from the

competitors list of the non informed weight group. If the athlete is competing over two days or more then he/she will be required to weigh each day prior to the tournament.

<u>For example</u>: An 18 year old male athlete competing in U18 and U21 events must signal that he will be fighting in the 2 categories at the weigh-in on the Friday evening. If he is fighting U18 and Senior then he must come to the Senior weigh-in on the Saturday evening. If not, he will not be allowed to participate in the Senior competition. The entrance fee for this competition will not be refunded.
