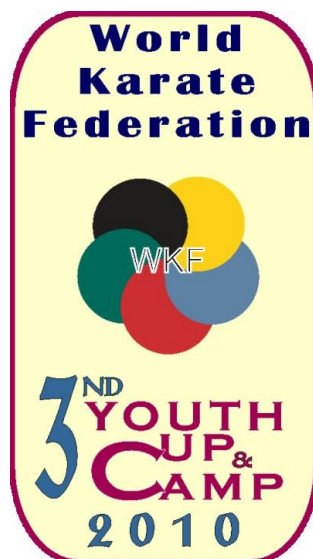

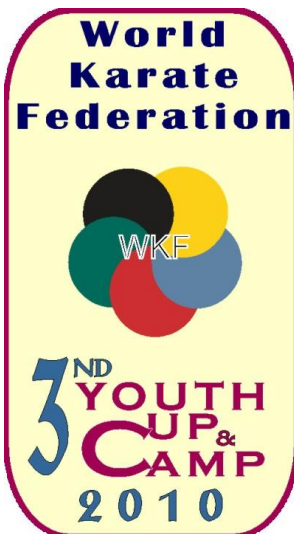

The Camp

Participating ages: **14, 15, 16, 17 years** old.

(Participants to the seminar must be born between 30th June 1992 and 29th June 1996)

☞ Younger or older participants will not be allowed.



All of the participants will stay at Corfu Holiday Palace and Ariti Hotel.

The participants to the seminar will pay **60 euro**, during the official registration (Corfu Holiday Palace 15:00-20:00, Monday 28 June) as **participation fee** for the youth seminar and they will get without additional charge the WKF ID card.

Participation to the WKF Youth World Cup will be free of charge.

Deadline for participating in the seminar is **30th of May 2010**.

In principle there will be a maximum number of forty (40) participants per National Federation.

Nobody will be accepted to the seminar once the official registration is over.

☞ As for the limited number of places the rule "first come first serve" will be followed; and the organization reserves the right not to accept any more applicants once the limit is reached.

All participants must bring with them the appropriate protective items (as per WKF rules), karate-gi and running shoes.

Every athlete will have to attend the seminar in order to participate in the World Cup. In the 3rd WKF Youth World Cup there will be Kata & Kumite competition as follows:

MALE JUNIOR INDIVIDUAL KUMITE (age 16 & 17)

-55, -61, -68, -76, +76 kg.

FEMALE JUNIOR INDIVIDUAL KUMITE (age 16 & 17)

-48, -53, -59, +59 kg.

MALE CADET INDIVIDUAL KUMITE (age 14 & 15)

-52, -57, -63, -70, +70 kg.

FEMALE CADET INDIVIDUAL KUMITE (age 14 & 15)

-47, -54, +54 kg.

MALE JUNIOR INDIVIDUAL KATA (age 16 & 17)

FEMALE JUNIOR INDIVIDUAL KATA (age 16 & 17)

MALE CADET INDIVIDUAL KATA (age 14 & 15)

FEMALE CADET INDIVIDUAL KATA (age 14 & 15)

Every competitor in Kata categories will present a maximum of five (5) different kata (2 shitei and 3 tokui).
