Participation	All EJU / IJF affiliated National Federations. National teams, regional and club selections entered exclusively through their National Federations In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer will inform immediately the NF concerned.		
Competition Mode	Double repechage competition system. Competition systems with low number of participants: 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin). 6 and more entries: repechage competition system Time of contests: 4 min. / Golden Score 2 min.		
Draw	Draw for all weight categories will be held on <u>Friday 22 April 2011 at 21:00</u> in <u>Hotel Panorama</u> . No Seeding, only separation by nations. <u>EJU / IJF Dress Code:</u> jacket suit with tie.		
Weigh in	Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits.		



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Refereeing	Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.														
Referee	All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring one IJF Referee A or B or a candidate at IJF Referee														
Judogi	The white and blue judogi are obligatory. Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. See Official Suppliers on the EJU website.														
Back Numbers	Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number . The 2010 EJU / IJF backnumber will be accepted in European Cups until 31 st December 2011. The back number must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com . Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.
