INTERNATIONAL JUDO SHOW CUP

Participants must be born in 1995 or before. They shall have a minimum of 1 Dan. Teams may be formed males and/or females.

COMPETITION FORMULA

The show is a technical confrontation of fight simulation containing techniques of judo and self-defense.

- Each show can be composed of 2 to 6 competitors
- Each team of judo show will be judged individually on a performance lasting 2 to 3 minutes.
- Should the performance be selected for the finals, it could be carried out with a classical numerical musical support that the candidates will provide to the organizer, during registration.
- During the whole day of competition, the candidates will have to present the same test.
- The accepted equipment is made up with an imitation of traditional weapons of Japanese origin or a gun as in the Goshin-jutsu.
- The performances are carried out in white judogi in conformity with the regulation of the official competitions.
- Phases of demonstration in slow motion are authorized.

The candidates will have to put forward their technical skills while respecting the judo spirit. The top three teams with the maximum points will be awarded the gold medal, the second will be awarded the silver medal; and the third the Bronze medal.

POINT SYSTEM

The show will be judged on the following criteria:

- Efficiency &Realistic
- Precision of the techniques
- Variety of the techniques
- Originality
- Choreographies
- Traditional

The total points accumulated will be the final result.

FEE

The inscription fee is 30 Euro per team (On place before competition).

JUDO SHOW OPEN DEMONSTRATION

To promote Judo Show this competition is open to:

Free teams composed of 2 to 6 judokas. Children must be born in 2004 or before mixed with adults can participate. Teams may be formed males and/or females.

Evaluations based on competition criteria.

No fee required.

The candidates will have to put forward their technical skills while respecting the judo spirit. All teams will be awarded by diploma or medal.

*For both formula the team has to provide to organizer music in CD format or MP3.

Team Club must be member of EJU / IJF recognized National Federation.

a. Medical certificate

For the FFBJ participants medical certificate is required.

For other participants the gender certificate and the medical certificate are not required.

The participants will compete under their full responsibility.

b. Insurance

Each National Federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against « injury and third part risk (public liability) » during the period of the competition.

The organizer declines all responsibility.

c. Attitude of the competitors

The member-Federations and Team leader are responsible for the behavior and attitude of their competitors at the contest.
