World Heritage Site by Unesco. Imperial City



The city of Toledo, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1986, is located on a rocky headland, bordered by the river Tajo in the very heart of Spain. Considered by many to be a "Second Rome", Toledo is still very much a unique city. Unique in its details, history, culture and charm. Three cultures from three single-faith religions – Muslim, Hebrew and Christian – left their imprints on this sad rock and cradle of civilizations – as Cervantes wrote – embracing the Tajo, witness to the mark of all the peoples of the Iberian Peninsula.

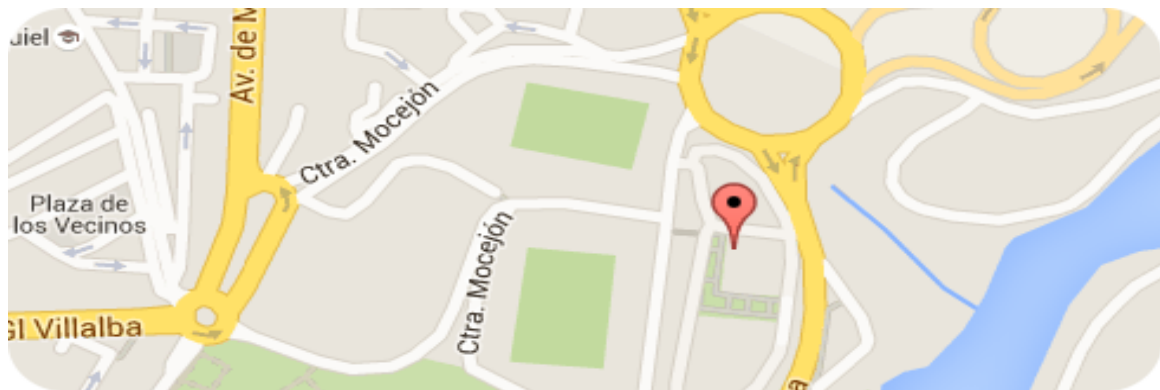
